Dear Parent,

Greetings from The Assam Valley School!

I am glad to inform you that a new MoU has been signed between The Assam Valley School and National Institute of Mountaineering and Allied Sports (NIMAS), Dirang which will provide our students with exciting opportunities in Mountaineering, Camping, Rafting and various other purposeful activities. A large number of US & European Universities give added advantage to admission aspirants if they have an exposure to adventure activities. A three-phase Adventure Programme of 15 days, divided into 5 days each in Class 8, 9 and 11 has been proposed by NIMAS towards this. The programme will comprise of rock climbing, white water rafting, trekking, camping in wilderness, emergency medicine and disaster relief. At the end of 15 days training, the students will be awarded with a certificate which will be in accordance with training standards required and recognized by the US/EU universities. Some of Indian Universities / Colleges have also started recognizing adventure activities and give some added marks/advantage to admission aspirants. Even if a student is not aspiring to go to a University abroad, this programme will be immense value as it aims at instilling a spirit of adventure in children and enhancing their decision-making skills. We have decided to send our class VIII students for a mandatory Adventure Engagement to NIMAS from the 22nd to the 28th of May, 2017. This engagement will be a part of the three-year programme stated above. The event will cost INR 9600/- (all-inclusive for this year) which will have to be paid by you in advance. I request you to complete the following procedure for your ward's participation in the programme:

- 1. Kindly pay the required amount (INR 9600/-) by on the day of your child's admission to the School by submitting a Bank Draft.
- 2. Please find attached herewith, two Indemnity Bonds. Kindly bring the completed Bonds for submission on the day of your child's admission to the school.
- 3. Please equip your ward with the items mentioned in the list before his/ her arrival at the School on the day of admission.
