**CRITERION FOR ADMISSION TO CLASS XI AT AVS AS FOLLOWS:**



- ✓ Pupils are requested to opt for **FIVE** subjects, including compulsory English.
- ✓ Science Stream will be offered only to pupils who secure a minimum of **70% in Science** in the **Pre- Board Examinations, 2017**.
- ✓ Pupils will be offered Mathematics in the Science Stream if they attain a minimum of **70% in Mathematics** in the **Pre- Board Examinations, 2017**.
- ✓ Pupils will be offered Mathematics in the Commerce Stream or with Economics only if they attain a minimum of **65% in Mathematics** in the **Pre- Board Examinations, 2017**.
- ✓ Pupils, who have **opted out of Science** at the ICSE level, **will not be permitted** to take up Science stream at the ISC level, Class 11.
- ✓ Pupils, who have **opted out of Mathematics at the ICSE level**, will not be permitted to take up **Mathematics at the ISC level**, Class 11 (Commerce or Humanities).
- ✓ Art / Music may be offered as a 6<sup>th</sup> subject according to the mutual convenience of the staff and Pupils.

## Notes on a few career prospects



**Fine Arts and Design:** Art will also be offered as a 6th subject, however the classes for Art will be conducted according to the mutual convenience of staff and pupils apart from the normal class time table.

**Environmental Science:** Colleges in different parts of the country look at subject choices and there is varied weightage to EVS. Delhi University (<http://www.du.ac.in>) and Kolkata University are great places to study; however, they do not give weightage to EVS under best Four (till the current year). However, other Universities in India & abroad accept these subjects in their best five.

**Mathematics:** Math is a compulsory subject in Delhi University and Kolkata University for pupils pursuing Economics. Math's in +2 is also essential for students desirous of perusing Management and Finance related Undergraduate degrees abroad - USA, Canada, UK, Singapore, Australia etc. While Mathematics is not a compulsory subject requirement in classes for 11 and 12 for MBA in India, it is an important component in entrance exams like CAT, MAT, XAT, NMAT etc. Entrance exams for LAW, Hotel Management, Mass Communication and Design have only class 10 level Mathematics. Entrance exams, to universities abroad require a pupil to take up SATs or GMATs which also require a substantial knowledge of Mathematics
