The RS delegates from fourteen participating schools in India, Bangladesh and Dubai assisted in masonry work, carpentry work, painting and mounting of the study material on the walls of the school during the scheduled Service Day on 14th December 2012, of Senior Regional [South Asia & Gulf] Round Square Conference. Any other information you would like to add	<p>Internationalism: The Craft Design & Technology (CDT) Centre of the Assam Valley School (AVS) collaborated with the Material Fiber Department of the Ontario College of Art & Design University (OCADU), Toronto, Canada, on an international level, eco-friendly project to extract Natural Dyes from indigenous plants and material of both the regions. In this regard, AVS students carried out focused research on the subject and managed to extract more than 125 shades of natural colours from the various plants and other material of Assam. On the other side of the globe, OCADU students studied the plants of the Aboriginal tribes of Canada and made colours using the natural techniques of these ancient elders of Canada. CDT Centre and OCADU cooperated extensively in the exchange of data and techniques on this subject and both the educational institutes benefitted immensely from this project. Such projects, with an international exposure, will go a long way in promulgating the usage of natural colours and appreciatively help in creating awareness on issues relating to the perils of Global Warming."</p> <p>Association with SPIC MACAY : The pupils were given a chance to participate / witness performances in SPIC MACAY "Virasat" at Tezpur Central University. Interaction with Padmashree Professor Kiran Seth, from IIT Delhi and founder of SPIC MACAY was organized at the school. Professor Seth addressed and interacted with all the pupils in the Middle School. 6 pupils in Oddissi dance form were trained by Mrs Kavita Dwibedi, a leading exponent of Oddissi Dance in India. 7 pupils in Sattriya dance form being trained by Guru Ghanakanta Borah 2 pupils in Vocal discipline being trained by Ustad Waseem Ahmed Khan The vocalist, Kaivalya Kumar Gaurav accompanied by percussionist Shubhankar Banerjee conducted a Lecture – Demonstration at the school.
