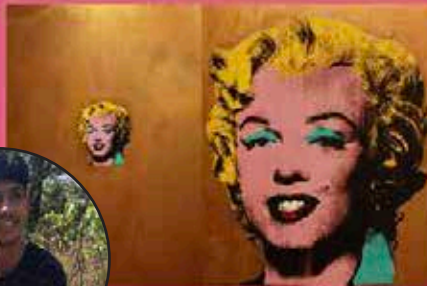

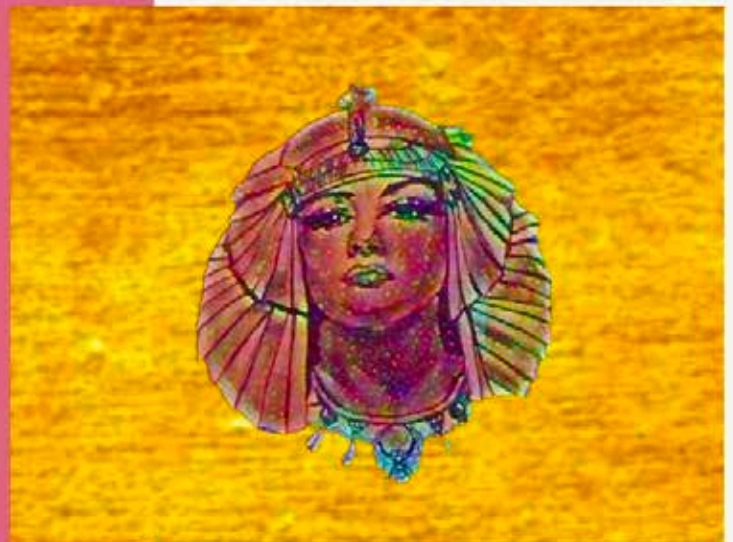

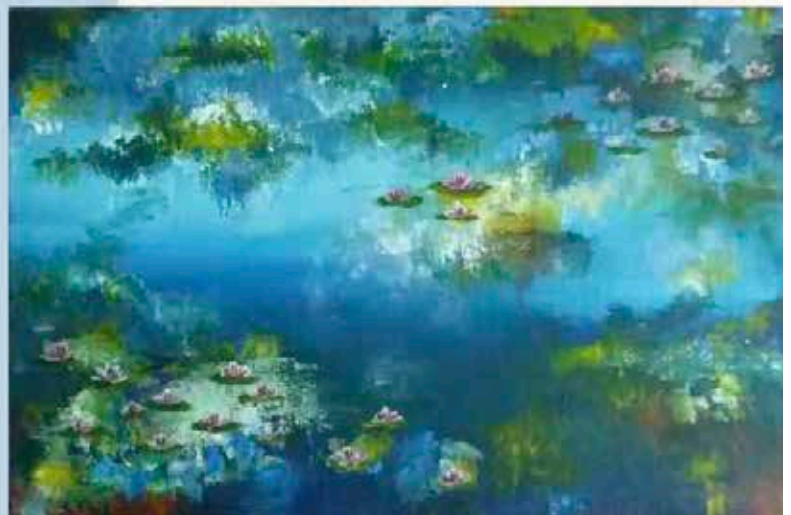

Woman with a Parasol was painted by Monet using the oil medium, while I have tried to replicate his work to some extent using acrylic colours. I have tried to bring out Monet's famous rapid brushstrokes in my art piece as well. As you can see, unlike the original, I have painted a Cessna 206 airplane model on the canvas which might seem queer as planes did not even exist in 1875, the year in which Monet painted the art piece. But I have done so because just like Monet's beautiful vision of a countryside involves Madame Monet and their son taking a stroll, the same way as I see myself amidst the greenery in Assam, lying on the grass, I always remember waiting to hear the sound of the Cessna which passes by frequently in the skies waiting to be spotted.

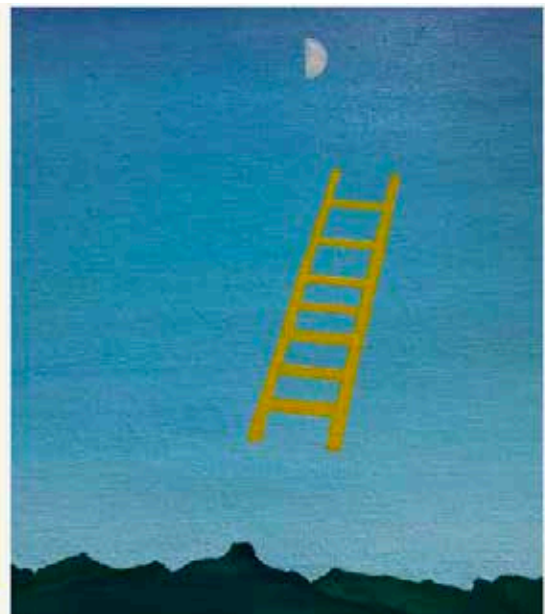
